

# London Centre of Self-Realization Fellowship Cookie Policy

As explained in this policy, when you visit the Self-Realization Fellowship Church - UK, or SRF-UK, and the London Centre of Self-Realization Fellowship Church – UK, or “Centre” (collectively “**London Centre**”) websites at srf-london.org.uk (collectively the “**Site**”), or use any London Centre internet services (collectively the “**Services**”), we may set cookies to support functionality and collect information about your use of our Site and Services. In addition, London Centre uses the services of third-parties to provide certain functionality on the Site. These third parties may set cookies as well.

A cookie is a small piece of data (text file) that a website stores on your computer or device in order to remember information about you, such as a unique identifier, your language preference or login information.

As explained in Section 3 below, you do not have to accept cookies and you may set your browser to restrict their use, and you may delete them after they have been placed on your hard drive or device. If you do not accept cookies, some areas of our Site or Services may take more time to work, or may not function properly.

## 1. Our First Party Cookies

**First party cookies** are cookies set by the Centre and through the Centre website domain you are visiting (such as srf-london.org.uk). We set the following categories of first-party cookies.

### *Necessary Session Cookies*

Our Necessary Session cookies are used to ensure that you are recognised when you move from page to page within our Site and that any information you have entered is remembered. These cookies are deleted when you close your web browser. You can set your browser to block these cookies, but some parts of the Site may not work then.

## 2. Third-Party Cookies

**Third party cookies** are set by a third party (not London Centre) and by a domain other than the London Centre website domain you are visiting (a domain other than srf-london.org.uk).

### a. Google Cookies

We use Google to provide calendar functionality on our calendar page, and Google may set Functional Cookies and Targeting Cookies.

### *Google Functional Cookies*

These cookies are used to provide services on the site, including providing the calendar functionality on our calendar page. You can set your browser to block these cookies, but then some parts of the site may not work.

## *Google Targeting Cookies*

Google may set these cookies to track your activities on our Site and other sites, and to build a profile of your interests, and to show you relevant ads on other sites. They work by uniquely identifying your browser or device. If you block these cookies, you may not experience targeted advertising on other sites.

### **b. MailChimp Cookies**

We use a company called MailChimp to distribute our London Centre email Newsletter. In certain cases, clicking the links in London Centre Newsletter will direct you through MailChimp's websites and servers in order to reach content. For example, the London Centre Newsletter contains links to our website, and links that allows newsletter recipients to retrieve newsletters online. Following these links will direct you through MailChimp's servers. MailChimp requires this for compliance reasons and we are unable to disable this functionality. However, please be aware that MailChimp's websites use cookies, and MailChimp and their service providers and others may collect and process personal data.
